HI HO CAHILL trailed to the stretch, rallied wide while being bothered and carried out, was just up. RUDE BOBBY had outside speed under pressure, drifted out and lost the lead into the stretch, rallied wide while continuing to drift wider through the stretch, bothering HI HO CAHILL, kept coming to dead heat. OUR BOY KEN forced the pace inside, opened up into the stretch, gave way late. SMARTY FAWCETT stalked wide, finished evenly. PULGARCITO stalked the forced pace inside, lacked a rally. DOUBLE CLUTCH stalked the forced pace off the rail early, advanced to press outside through the final turn, faded in the stretch. The rider aboard HI HO CAHILL lodged a claim of foul against the rider of RUDE BOBBY for interference in the stretch. RUDE BOBBY was disqualified and placed second.
