REBA tracked the leader inside, forced the issue between horses on the final turn, made a bid inside the winner to near mid stretch, gave way. MOMMA TWO SHOES saved ground, rallied for the show inside. SHE'S ABOVE DA LAW saved ground, made a bid between horses on the final turn, gave way. MISS MONEY TRAIN opened up early, had outside pressure on the final turn, gave way in early stretch. FAHSPA, wide early, faded.
