Footnotes

PULGARCITO stalked outside, forced the issue outside through the final turn, dueled into the stretch, took a short lead in mid stretch, held on. DOUBLE CLUTCH, off the rail, forced the pace between horses from mid backstretch to midway through the final turn, shook his pace rivals, was taken on by the winner, dueled inside into the stretch, gave his best, couldn't match the winner. TOCCER saved ground, third best. ZEE THRONE trailed early, advanced off the rail. TRICK OR BLUFF opened up early, had outside pressure on the backstretch, gave way midway through the final turn. BABY FACE ASSASSIN showed little off the rail. TROJAN FOR LIFE advanced to press outside, gave way between horses midway through the final turn.
