FORCHTENBERG stalked outside, advanced in late turn to take over into the stretch, opened up, held well. NO REPLY stalked off the rail, followed the winner home second best. CATMANTOO trailed wide early, stalked outside, rallied between horses. CANCERBERO, well placed inside, made a bid between horses in late turn, was no match for the winner, gave way. COASTAL KING, back early, advanced off the rail. BUFF DADDY saved ground. LIGHTHOUSE JUDGE opened up early, had outside pressure late on the final turn, gave way. WAGELS tracked the leader inside, faded on the final turn.
