Footnotes

RUCKUS RULES, back early, advanced wide, came with a long steady rally to get by late. DONABILITY dueled three-wide, continued to duel outside in the stretch, won the duel late, missed. BEAR IN CONTROL dueled between horses, dueled inside through the stretch, gave his best to the wire. MR. MALABAR stalked the duel outside, rallied belatedly. AIREN stalked the duel inside, rallied evenly. MONEY BARON saved ground. PREVAILING WIND (GB) stalked off the rail, lacked a rally. BOB'S MISSILE dueled inside, gave way in early stretch. ROUGH N' ROWDY showed little back and outside.
