E HARNER, always well placed inside back of the leader, rallied off the rail to be up late. BARRAMOON stalked outside, finished well to take over late, missed. CROWNED ROYAL stalked wide, finished well. TUG O' WAR opened up early, set a slow pace, took a good lead into the stretch, gave way late. KRIS COLUMBUS saved ground, advanced off the rail. I'MNOTEASYIMACINCH, inside early, stalked between horses, lacked the needed rally. BOBBY AND BOB trailed to the stretch, advanced widest, passed tired rivals. THE SUPPLY PROGRAM showed little back and outside. MUDCHUTE, well placed outside, faded late on the final turn.
