Footnotes

TAXI FLEET dropped back early, advanced to stalk the duel from the outside on the turn, challenged four-wide into the stretch, dueled, drew out from mid stretch. SOUPED UP pressed outside early, dueled three-wide through the turn and into the stretch, gave way, kept coming to take the place. BONDSTEEL stalked between horses, well placed back of the duel on the turn, rallied for the show. MANCINI'S AIR RAID stalked between horses, dropped back on the turn, rallied outside. ACTION SKETCH pressed between horses early, dueled between horses through the turn and into the stretch, gave way passing the sixteenth pole. ROMAN ACCOUNT, well placed inside, stalked a duel on the turn, lacked a rally. RILEYS SPRINTEN opened a short clear lead early, dueled inside through the turn and into the stretch, gave way in mid stretch.
