MYGALLOVESGOLD opened up early, turned back a mild outside bid from INDEFINITE in late turn, took a good lead into the stretch, held well. INDEFINITE tracked the leader off the rail, made an outside bid in late turn, came up second best. JOHNNY NICOLETT, back early, advanced wide. REASON TO PARTY bumped ROCK N ROYAL shortly after the break, tracked the leader off the rail, rallied evenly. EDGE OF THE WORLD, wide early, off the rail on the turn, rallied evenly. COCKTAILS AT FIVE showed little between horses. SCIRO, well placed inside early, faded. ROCK N ROYAL, bumped at the start, saved ground.
