Footnotes

DEEP DIVE, back early, advanced off the rail on the final turn, took over along the rail in early stretch, opened up, held well. O K INDY, back early, advanced wide in late final turn, finished well to take the place. MR EXSPEEDIENT forced the pace inside, opened up before a half had been run, had outside pressure on the final turn, shook his pace rival into the stretch, couldn't stay with the winner when that one challenged, made a good place bid before tiring. ORVILLE GOT EVEN stalked the forced pace inside, finished evenly. COOL LION stalked off the rail, lacked the needed rally. VADER stalked the forced pace outside, forced the issue through the final turn, was turned back into the stretch. HE IS had outside speed under pressure, dropped back before a half had been run, faded.
