GUNTON ROAD trailed, started a long rally three wide, heading into the second turn, gained command in mid stretch, and drew off. GAZY GUS stalked the pace from off the rail, assumed command in upper stretch, gave way in mid stretch, and was second best. RHYTHMIC SONG was well placed inside, made a mild bid in upper stretch, and held the show position. MAMASAYSNO was four wide on the first turn, then off the rail, gained mildly late while four wide. LILORPHANFRED had speed to clear, tired on the second turn. JOHNNY NICOLETT raced off the rail, made a mild bid upper stretch, and faltered late. LOST RIDGE was reluctant to load, raced wide throughout, and showed little. STALLWALKER was four wide, and faded.
