E HARNER trailed early, advanced inside, rallied outside, took over late. MOVED TO PERMA stalked the pressured pace outside, challenged three-wide into the stretch, dueled, made a bid to the sixteenth pole, gave way. SLEWS DARK KNIGHT pressed outside, forced the issue outside through the final turn, shook his duel rival in late turn, dueled inside into the stretch, gave way nearing the sixteenth pole. NORTHERN LUST dueled inside early, remained well placed inside, stalked the bid battle through the final turn, finished evenly. GEAR SHIFT, back and outside, lacked the needed rally. DOUBLE JACK dueled outside early, opened a short clear lead on the backstretch, dueled inside through the final turn, gave way TIZZYS DESERT STAR saved ground, faded.
