Footnotes

PURE OXYGEN stalked the forced pace off the rail early, pressed five-wide on the turn, finished well to take over late. GENTLEMAN VYE pressed four-wide, rallied to take over after passing the sixteenth pole, couldn't match the winner late. MOMENT OF SONG stalked the forced pace inside, waited mildly through he turn, got through into the stretch, challenged passing the eighth pole, made a bid to the sixteenth pole. ECTON'S GEM forced the pace three-wide through the turn, dropped back in late turn. MANCINI'S AIR RAID forced pace between horses from the two-path, gave way passing the eighth pole. KIELBASA saved ground, finished best of the rest. SWEETSOUTHERNSTYLE, wide early, faded. SMART TIME had inside speed under pressure, gave way passing the eighth pole.
