BOO BUNNY pressed outside, forced the issue between horses into the final turn, challenged outside into the stretch, gave her best, couldn't get to the winner. REBA, well placed inside, stalked a bid battle on the final turn, advanced inside, challenged along the rail into the stretch, gave her best to the wire. STYLISH LADY trailed to the stretch, advanced off the rail. HILLARY'S HARBOR pressed three-wide, forced the issue into the final turn, was turned back in late turn, faded. MIDNIGHT CRUISER stalked outside, lacked a rally.
