EXPLODING CRYSTALS, back and wide early, wide on the turn, six-wide into the stretch, took over passing the sixteenth pole, drew out late. SONG OF KATEPWA stalked the duel off the rail, made a bid between horses passing the sixteenth pole, couldn't match the winner late. HAGGAI stalked the duel inside, challenged along the rail in the stretch, made a bid to the sixteenth pole. FIRM GOLD dueled between horses, forced the issue through the turn, gave way in late turn. OVID FASTI dueled three-wide, forced the issue through the turn, gave way in late turn. FLEEING FAST dueled inside, shook her pace rivals in late turn, gave way between horses in mid stretch. PRESERVATA took a bad step early, steadied, took multiple bad steps passing the three-eighths pole, was eased and vanned off.
