COIN AGAIN stalked between horses early, was inside on the turn, rallied inside, just got up late for the win. MEOW WOW stalked off the rail, advanced wide on the turn, rallied off the rail, just missed. REGAL FOREST forced pace outside, three-wide bid turn, took over in late turn, led late, was outfinished by the top two. BENZERELLA broke a step slow, was inside early, finished well outside. RIYO saved ground, had a mild rally off the rail. WINTERPEG inside speed under pressure, gave way mid stretch. TOO HOT FOR BOYS dueled outside, tired late. PRIMA RIDER trailed throughout.
