ADDIE'S PRIDE forced the pace outside, took a short but clear lead into the turn, opened up into the stretch, drew off. MILLIE TIME, well placed inside early, had to wait from mid to late turn along rail behind the winner when ready to challenge that one, gave her best chasing the winner home. CAILA stalked the forced pace off the rail, was third best. AMPERAGE chased outside, tired in the drive. MARCO ROSE, wide on the backstretch, finished best of the rest. CIRCULATING MOTION, well placed inside, faded. HAIDA BELLS showed little. MISS LILLY'S IMAGE widest on the backstretch, faded. DAKOTA SEAL back and off the rail, faded. MISS GOLDEN DARBY was wide, tired.
