### Footnotes

SASSY CASSIE pressed wide early, well placed outside on the turn, came with a determined drive to take over late. SINGLE N LOVIN IT stalked the forced pace off the rail early, outside on the turn, finished well. QUEEN OF TAHOE took a short lead between horses early, opened up inside into the turn, increased her margin in early stretch, gave way late. REBA forced the pace inside early, remained well placed inside on the turn, rallied belatedly. LATIN JOURNEY passed a tired rival. PLUS ULTRA broke slow, advanced to force the pace between horses early, dropped back off the rail on the turn, faded.
