EL CADETE had outside speed under pressure, had his hind heels clipped while moving to the lead early on the final turn, led, jumped shadows in mid turn, dropped back, re-rallied outside to be just up. ART EXPRESS stalked off the rail, advanced to force the issue midway through the final turn, opened up into the stretch, tired late. BELLISSIMO JOE saved ground, advanced for the show. MATTY MY BOY, back early, galloped home from the final turn due to a fallen horse. FASTY'SNASTYRASCAL steadied between horses into the first turn when MALIBU BULLET came out slightly, dropped back, stalked inside, faded. MALIBU BULLET forced the pace inside, clipped heels early on the final turn as the winner moved to the lead, fell, lost the rider. The rider aboard BELLISSIMO JOE lodged a claim of foul against the rider of ART EXPRESS for interference into the first turn. There was no change. Following a STEWARDS INQUIRY, EL CADETE was disqualified and placed last for interference early on the final turn.
