THEE HEMI stalked the forced pace off the rail, challenged into the stretch, made a bid to mid stretch, held the show. ECTON'S GEM stalked outside, finished evenly. DADDY'S VISION forced the pace inside, made a bid between horses to mid stretch, gave way. OUR BOY KEN had outside speed under pressure, gave way between horses in mid stretch. LUCAVA saved ground. GO MY CHAMP showed little.
