LOTS OF CHROME pressed widest, took a short lead four-wide on late backstretch, opened up in early stretch, drew out. BADJO BADJO BADJO tracked the leader off the rail, made a bid between horses on late backstretch, dropped back inside on the turn, rallied along the rail to take the place. I'MINITOWINIT opened up on the first turn, was pressured on late backstretch, gave way in early stretch. GOLDEN TOCCET stalked outside, rallied belatedly. FABULOUS GOLD, well placed inside to the final turn, moved outside, lacked a rally. ORCHESTRATION, well placed between horses, made a bid between horses into the final turn, gave way. OXFORD CITY SLEW showed little wide.
