ALLISON'S TIGER had inside speed under pressure, took a short clear lead into the stretch, held on. CABOOSEONTHELOOSE pressed widest early, forced the issue three-wide on the turn, was turned back into the stretch, kept coming. FELTED stalked the forced pace inside, rallied outside. MR SUPER SONIC forced the pace between horses, was turned back into stretch, made a place bid before tiring. HOOVES ON FIRE stalked off the rail, rallied belatedly. LAC LU saved ground, lacked a rally. ECHO MIKE passed a tired rival. BARRISTER DON had early speed between horses, well placed into the turn, faded outside.
