### Footnotes

PIVOT PAD dueled inside, opened up into the stretch, held well. KBELLO dueled outside, was turned back in late turn, kept coming outside. POSITIVE FORCE stalked the duel inside, finished evenly. THE PHENOM stalked the duel off the rail, lacked a rally. HI HO CAHILL broke slow, passed a tired rival. KING COLA stalked the duel off the rail early, drifting out on the turn, faded.
