PATRIOTIC GENERAL dueled outside early, dueled inside through the turn and into the stretch, gradually shook his outside rival in the drive, drew out late. WARONTHEHOMEFRONT stalked the duel outside early, dueled outside through the turn and into the stretch, made a bid to late stretch before tiring. ANCIENT SYMBOL stalked the duel off the rail, finished evenly. DOUBLE CLUTCH stalked wide, finished evenly. DAVE'S DECADENCE broke slow, well back early, advanced outside. SPRING SOUP showed little inside. MAN ON THE MOON dueled inside early, gave way into the turn.
