**Footnotes**

AMERICAN POET tracked the leader inside, had to wait briefly in early and late turn when ready to run, got through inside when R LUMBER drifted out into the stretch, held off rivals in a stretch long drive. WAR ON TERROR pressed outside, was carried wide between horses into the stretch, kept coming to take the place. MOMENT OF SONG stalked off the rail, made a bid between horses through the stretch, tired late. MR. NUTCRACKER stalked wide, advanced to press wide on the turn, was carried wider into the stretch, lacked a rally. R LUMBER opened a short clear lead early, was challenged in late turn, drifted out into the stretch, made a bid to mid stretch, tired. BACK PACK SHACK steadied at the break, showed little. RUNS IN THE FAMILY showed little, pulled up in the stretch.
