WORKINONNITMOVES had rated speed outside, opened up in early stretch, drew out. MY FAST ONE stalked off the rail, advanced outside on the turn, rallied to be just up for the place. PRAIRIE ECLIPSE trailed early, advanced inside, rallied to make a place bid. DAYDREAM DANCER had inside speed under pressure, gave way into the stretch. I'MONFIREFORELVIRA stalked the forced pace off the rail, faded. THREE BLIND MICE stalked the forced pace inside early, dropped back on the turn. HIGHJUMPINJENNIE, well placed between horses early, faded on the turn.
