HURRI UP, widest early, pressed outside, forced the issue on the the final turn, dueled through the stretch, prevailed late. GAZY GUS opened up early, had outside pressure after a half, dueled inside through the stretch, gave his best before giving way. MAINTENANCE MAN, always well placed inside, gained mildly in the stretch. GUNTON ROAD stalked outside, advanced on the final turn, hung in the drive. BILLY'S WARRIOR stalked outside, pressed three-wide on the final turn, tired in the stretch. SCHMATZ saved ground, finished evenly. INTO OVERTIME, widest early, stalked wide, faded. THE TIME IS RIGHT passed tired rivals. ALBEDO, well placed between horses early, faded.
