MALTESE PINS, always well placed outside, stalked a bid battle through the final turn, rallied outside to take over late. OUR BOY KEN dueled inside early, dropped back to track the leader, advanced outside to duel through the final turn, opened up into the stretch, gave his best, couldn't hold late. LUCAVA, well placed inside, stalked a bid battle through the final turn, finished evenly. TIZZYS DESERT STAR advanced off the rail. JESS Z dueled outside early, opened up on the backstretch, dueled inside through the final turn, gave way into the stretch. STARPONE stalked off the rail, faded. MANDOORULE saved ground, faded. CERTAINLY CERTAIN trailed early, was eased on the backstretch.
