WAGELS had inside speed under pressure, opened up on the final turn, took a good lead into the stretch, had something left at the wire. CAPTAIN DUDE trailed to the stretch, rallied wide. TATLER JACK forced the pace outside, gave way into the final turn, held the show. HOOVES ON FIRE saved ground, rallied mildly. KRIS COLUMBUS back and inside early, advanced off the rail in the stretch. HARBOR WIN stalked wide, rallied mildly. RUCKUS RULES stalked outside, advanced wide. LEGS ELEVEN stalked between horses, finished evenly. TIZZYS DESERT STAR, well placed inside, rallied between horses, tired. ASCARI stalked between horses, lacked a rally. WOODSHED, well placed outside, tired in the stretch. STARPONE, wide early, faded.
