SO GONE pressed inside early, took a short lead into the turn, opened up into the stretch, held well. SOUPED UP, back early, advanced wide on the turn, rallied. E HARNER stalked the forced pace inside, made a place bid in the stretch before tiring. BUNGEE JUMPER, well placed off the rail, lacked the needed rally. HOPETOWN HERO, wide early, between horses on the turn, lacked a rally. POLISH GAME, back early, stalked wide, finished best of the rest. BONDSTEEL passed tired rivals. SEISMATIC had outside speed under pressure, forced the issue through the turn, gave way into the stretch. MANCINI'S AIR RAID, well placed inside to the turn, dropped back, faded.
