STILL FLYING stalked the forced pace inside, challenged three-wide into the stretch, dueled, drew out from mid stretch. WINTERPEG had speed off the rail under pressure, dueled between horses into the stretch, gave way in mid stretch. TOO HOT FOR BOYS stalked outside, rallied to take the show. BELLEBUIE forced the pace inside, advanced to take a short lead into the stretch, dueled, gave way passing the eighth pole. VERDOT trailed to the stretch, passed tired rivals. MEOW WOW stalked off the rail, lacked a rally. PRIMA RIDER saved ground. G. P'S LEGACY, wide early, dropped back outside.
