WINNER IN OVERTIME trailed early, advanced inside, rallied up the rail to take over in mid stretch, drew out. PIVOT PAD forced the pace inside early, pressed inside through the turn, gave his best in the stretch. PAYMENT APPROVED stalked outside, rallied wide. TAKEHOME ASOUVENIR saved ground, finished evenly. SENATOR MATTY had speed off the rail under pressure, took a short lead into the stretch, gave way in mid stretch. THE PHENOM forced the pace four-wide early, well placed outside on the turn, faded. CHILLY WILLY passed a tired rival. NEVERDIDITTWICE forced the pace between horses early, dropped back after a quarter.
