MOSEL RIVER stalked wide, made a place bid in the stretch, finished evenly. GEAR SHIFT trailed early, advanced inside. POSITIVE FORCE, well placed inside, faded in the stretch. DAILYDBLNOTROUBLE dueled outside early, dropped back to stalk, well placed outside on the final turn, faded. E HARNER stalked off the rail, faded. SID THE KID, wide early, dropped back, faded.
