ANCELLOTTA had outside speed under pressure, opened up, took the inside, turned back rivals late on the final turn, opened up, held on. ARVALANY'S MISTAKE trailed to the final turn, finished well wide. GARDEN BALLAD stalked between horses, advanced into the stretch, made a place bid in the drive. SHARIS REPORT, inside early, stalked off the rail, made a three-wide bid on the final turn, tired in the drive after making a place bid. D D'S POSTMASTER forced the pace inside early, made a bid between horses on the final turn, tired. PRAIRIEPRANCER passed tired rivals. REDNA AGAIN saved ground, faded. SOMETHING POSITIVE stalked wide, faded.
