JENNA LU HU set a slow pace inside under mild pressure, opened up into the final turn, was never in doubt from that point on. EXHILARATED, back early, advanced off the rail, gave her best in the stretch. FATAL ZONE forced the pace outside to the final turn, inside on the turn, lacked a rally. GREENSTONE stalked off the rail, improved her position. EASTERS LILY stalked the forced pace inside, faded. SO LIKE A TIGER stalked the forced pace off the rail, well placed on the final turn, faded. HEIDI'S ROSETTE showed little. FOLLOW UP broke on top, rated off a slow pace, faded. STREAMLET showed little.
