WILLOW ISLAND dueled inside throughout, missed. CHASING A DREAM steadied early, stalked outside, finished well. GARDEN SONG, outside early, off the rail on the turn, rallied belatedly. DUBONNET stalked a duel inside early, pressed three-wide in late turn, was turned back.
