MALAMEEZE dueled inside early, opened a short lead on the backstretch, turned back a bid from SKIING CHUMAREE on the final turn, opened up into the stretch, drew out. MARAVILLOSA MARCOS, back and inside early, advanced wide, rallied. HERATS MISSILE stalked off the rail, made a place bid inside in the drive. SKIING CHUMAREE dueled outside early, well placed just back and outside of the winner to the final turn, forced the issue through the turn, was turned back in early stretch. LONG GONE BALDRY stalked outside, finished evenly. SIMPLY ELUSIVE broke awkwardly, well placed outside to the final turn, faded. PULLEDMEOUT passed a tired rival. WHISKEY SAINT, well placed inside to the final turn, faded.
