CAFE AU MEY stalked outside, pressed three-wide after a half, dueled into the stretch, drew out after passing the eighth pole. COLONY QUEEN trailed to the stretch, rallied outside. GAMESHY saved ground, rallied belatedly between horses. LEGS ELEVEN forced the pace inside early, dropped back to stalk on the backstretch, moved to force the issue between horses after a half, made a bid between horses through the final turn and into the stretch, gave way passing the eighth pole. OVID FASTI had outside speed under early pressure, opened up on the backstretch, had outside pressure after a half, dueled into the stretch, gave way passing the eighth pole. INSPEIGHTOFSUCCESS, well placed off the rail, stalked a bid battle on the final turn, lacked a rally. OLD WAY stalked inside, faded.
