MOSAICO forced the pace outside, took a short clear lead midway through the final turn, was challenged again into the stretch, initially turned back LUCKY LADY GO, was forced to turn that one back again in mid stretch when she came again, appeared to have her inside rival put away for good in deep stretch when she came over and bothered that one. LUCKY LADY GO had inside speed under pressure, lost the lead on the final turn, came again into the stretch to challenge, was turned back, came again to challenge in mid stretch, was turned back passing the sixteenth pole, was under right handed urging while fading when the winner came over, forcing her to check. LITTLE WIDOW MAKER stalked off rail, advanced for the show. JILLEAH stalked the forced pace off the rail, lacked the needed rally. REGAL LION stalked inside, faded. The rider aboard LUCKY LADY GO lodged a claim of foul against the rider of MOSAICO for interference in deep stretch. MOSAICO was subsequently disqualified and placed second.
