MISS KUMARI had inside speed under pressure, opened up after a quarter, drew out. TOTALLY BUSTED tracked the winner off the rail, held the place. TOP ROCKETTE stalked outside, rallied belatedly. ROX AND ROLLS stalked wide, rallied belatedly. SHE'S THE FASHION stalked widest, tired. OPEN THE WINE, back early, advanced inside. SCATTERBERRY, well placed inside to late turn, faded. ALITTLESALTNLIME stalked between horses, lacked a rally. JUKEBOX JANE saved ground. NEEDLESTICK forced the pace outside early, dropped back on the turn, faded.
