WANDO'S APPEAL trailed early, advance inside on the turn, came off the rail in the stretch, and prevailed. BANG ON THE MONEY stalked the pace three wide, advanced on the turn, gained command passing the quarter pole, gave way in mid stretch, and was second best. PETRO BULL raced three wide, and rallied mildly. MASON DIXON LINE set the pace, tired in upper stretch. SNAPPY CHAPPY stalked the pace three wide, faltered on the turn. BRIGEM D stalked the pace from the inside, and dropped back. ADDITIONAL EXPENSE raced off the rail, and showed little.
