LEGS ELEVEN stalked the duel from back and off the rail early, advanced four-wide on the final turn, opened up into the stretch, held well. SHEZA CARCHY trailed to the stretch, advanced between horses to take the place. RIVER SLANEY trailed to the stretch, advanced five-wide in late turn, rallied mildly. GEORGE'S GAL dueled outside, gave way between horses in late turn. HALO'S RING pressed outside, made a three-wide bid between horses on the final turn, gave way in late turn. GRAND VISION had inside speed under pressure, gave way in late turn. RESTLESS SAINT stalked the forced pace inside, lacked a rally.
