Footnotes

RIYO pressed inside, challenged along the rail in late turn, opened up into the stretch, drew out. MAUB pressed between horses early, pressed outside on the turn, made a bid four-wide in late turn, kept coming to take the place. NO REFLECTION stalked wide, back of bid battle in late turn, took the show. WINTERPEG dueled off the rail inside, dueled off the rail from the two-path on the turn, shook her pace rivals just as the winner was advancing inside to take over in late turn, tired in the drive. PRIMA RIDER saved ground. MEOW WOW stalked off the rail, lacked a rally. TOO HOT FOR BOYS dueled wide early, dueled between horses three-wide through the turn, gave way in late turn. BIXETTE showed little.
