EXHILARATED pressed widest early, forced the issue four-wide on the turn, challenged outside into the stretch, wore down J P'S HANNAH in the drive to take over late, drew out. J P'S HANNAH stalked the duel off the rail, challenged outside into the stretch, took over in mid stretch, gave her best, couldn't match the winner late. WILD N' MAGIC broke slow, advanced inside to force the pace into the turn, dueled inside to mid stretch, gave way. STREAMLET trailed to the stretch, advanced inside. INJIA dueled between horses, gave way in late turn. FATAL ZONE stalked wide, lacked a rally. CITY COLORS dueled inside early, dueled between horses through the turn, gave way. FOLLOW UP saved ground, faded.
