Footnotes

LONG GONE BALDRY stalked the forced pace off the rail, advanced between horses on the final turn, finished well to get by late. MR. MALABAR forced the pace three-wide, opened up into the stretch, gave way late. A. W. SHUCKS saved ground, rallied evenly inside. RYTHM INDY BLUES stalked off the rail, rallied belatedly. WARREN'S PRICELESS stalked the forced pace outside early, dropped back, re-advanced into the stretch. MAGICAL MATT stalked wide, lacked the needed rally. HEMSKY had inside speed under pressure, gave way late on the final turn. BELIEVE ME I KNOW forced the pace between horses, gave way midway through the final turn. QUATARI showed little back and outside. GREEN BAY ROAD passed a tired rival. PLATINUM HUNTER broke a step slow, widest on the first turn, dropped back, faded.
