Footnotes

FORCHTENBERG saved ground, had to wait behind horses on the final turn, finished well inside to take over late. MATTY PROUD opened a short clear lead on the first turn, increased his margin on the final turn, gave his best under pressure in the drive, couldn't hold late. MALAMEEZE stalked off the rail, outside on the final turn, rallied outside to take the show. BEAUCARDI tracked the leader off the rail, made a bid between horses into the stretch, was turned back. SPYING EYES tracked the leader inside, well placed off the rail on the final turn, lacked the needed rally. PRAYFORTHE SOLDIERS trailed to the stretch, passed tired rivals. HEAP WAMPUM, wide early, back and outside backstretch, lacked a rally. POSTMASTER GENERAL pressed outside early, dropped back to stalk, faded.
