MAJOR HURRICANE forced the pace three-wide, dueled into the stretch, shook his inside rival after passing the eighth pole, just held off FARM HAND in the drive. FARM HAND, back and off the rail early, pressed four-wide into the final turn, dueled outside into the stretch, was turned back, kept coming, just missed. APPLICANT, back early, advanced wide, rallied into the slow pace, just held the show. HOP ALONG HARRY trailed to the final turn, advanced off the rail, finished well. MT. CHARLES had inside speed under pressure, dueled into the stretch, gave way after passing the eighth pole. JUSTLIKEACOWBOY forced the pace between horses, gave way after passing the midpoint of the final turn. COUNTRY GROOM stalked the forced pace between horses, faded. MR. NOMER stalked the forced pace inside, faded on the final turn. INTO OVERTIME stalked the forced pace outside, faded.
