MISS SMOKE SIGNALS opened up early, increased her margin to the stretch, was never in doubt. EXHILARATED saved ground, rallied inside to take the place. DOTTIR stalked off the rail, rallied between horses to make a place bid. TOP ROCKETTE, outside early, off the rail in late turn, rallied to make a place bid. ATTA' GIRL, well placed off the rail, tired in the stretch. NO IMAGE showed little. TIGER GROVE passed tired rivals. FIRM GOLD, wide early, between horses into the turn, faded. DIAMOND BRITE tracked the winner inside to the stretch, faded.
