CALITOR pressed outside early, forced the issue down the backstretch and into the final turn, opened up into the stretch, held well. APT TO PAY stalked the forced pace inside, had to wait in late turn, rallied from the eighth pole when clear. MAINTENANCE MAN forced the pace outside early, dropped back to stalk the pace battle, kept coming in the drive. APRIL'S HOPE stalked off the rail, rallied belatedly. NO GIMMICK trailed to the stretch, rallied wide. MOVED TO PERMA had inside speed under pressure, gave way late on the final turn. AY DIOS MIO showed little back and outside. NEW GENERATION stalked the forced pace outside, faded in the stretch. LILY'S KNIGHT showed little back and inside.
