HAZE N HARLEE, back early, advanced off the rail on the final turn, rallied outside to take over late, held on for the dead-heat. APPLICANT trailed to the stretch, rallied wide to be just up in a dead-heat for win. FABULOUS GOLD had inside speed under pressure, forced the issue on the backstretch and final turn, took a short lead into the stretch, shook his final pace rival in mid stretch, tired late. JUST ADD SALT, outside early, advanced to force the pace wide on the backstretch, gave way passing the eighth pole. SUDDEN BOLT had speed between horses, took a short lead on the backstretch, forced the issue into the stretch, made a bid to mid stretch. DIXIELAND GOLD pressed between horses on the backstretch, dropped back after a half to stalk a bid battle on the final turn, faded.
