Footnotes

OLD WAY pressed outside early, forced the issue through the turn and into the stretch, opened up in mid stretch, drew out. CROWNING ERA forced the pace outside early, led inside under pressure through the turn and into the stretch, gave way under pressure in mid stretch. FARWAIN stalked the forced pace off the rail, couldn't gain in the drive. DEMI'S PLEASURE stalked off the rail, outside on the turn, finished evenly inside. C C'S JEANS passed tired rivals. GOLD MINSTREL stalked the forced pace inside early, off the rail on the turn, faded. AFRICAN DREAM had inside speed under pressure, dropped back after a quarter.
